**ORDER**

1. This Court has jurisdiction and power to make and enforce rules governing the professional conduct of lawyers who are members of the Muscogee Nation Bar Association as they practice before the Courts of the Muscogee Nation in the administration of justice, and serve clients within the Muscogee Nation.

2. The Court adopts the 2007 Edition of the American Bar Association (ABA) Model Rules of Professional Conduct which are incorporated herein by reference as they appear on the ABA website: [www.abanet.org/cpr/mrpc/model\\_rules](http://www.abanet.org/cpr/mrpc/model_rules). The Court does not officially adopt the comments to the Model Rules, but they are provided for guidance only.

3. It is further ordered that the 2007 Edition of the ABA Model Rules of Professional Conduct may be amended from time to time by this Court upon its own motion or upon consideration of a duly made recommendation of the Muscogee Nation Bar Association.

4. This Order shall be released for official publication and a copy of this Order shall be mailed to all members of the Muscogee Nation Bar Association.
